



Front Line Health Care Personnel Assistance Fund

The Front Line Health Care Personnel Assistance Fund is available to graduates of Valley Falls USD 338 (or their spouse) who are starting or continuing their education in the health care field. Preference will be given when the applicant is pursuing a second career in life or entering the medical field after raising their children. Applicants pursuing a Medical Doctor or Registered Nurse (RN) degree are not eligible for this scholarship.

This is an open application, with no set due date. You may submit your application at any time. The selection committee may act on each application when it is received or hold until funding is available. Assistance amount is need based as determined by the selection committee.

Examples of eligible courses of study are, but not limited to:

- EMT, Emergency Medical Technician
- LPN, Licensed Practical Nurse
- CNA, Certified Nursing Assistant
- CMA, Certified Medical Assistant
- HCT, Home Care Technician
- HMA, Home Health Aide
- MOA, Medical Office Assistant

To apply, submit a letter stating the reasons you think you are good choice for this program. Please include a summary of your life, your future goals, where you will be attending school and what you will be studying.

The selection committee shall have at least three members that are graduates of USD 338; two of the members should be employed in the health care field and one member should be interested in the betterment of the Valley Falls community.

If you are selected to receive support from the assistance fund, you will be notified via letter and asked to provide information on where you will be attending school and proof of enrollment before a check will be sent to the school of your choosing.
